



Camp Na-Bor-Lee Policies and Rules

A National Park Service facility.

Policy Statement: The following rules will govern Camp operations. The leader, whose name is on the reservations, will be responsible for sharing the rules and ensuring their group follows them. For the safety and enjoyment of all campers these policies will be strictly enforced.

1. Check-in and check-out: Check-out by 12:00 pm. Check in after 2:00 pm. If you have a reservation, you can arrive any time after 2 pm, but must check in prior to 10 am the morning after the first night of your reservation or your reservation will be cancelled, unless caretakers have been contacted.
2. Garbage: Campers must remove all garbage, including garbage in bathrooms, at the end of their stay. There is a garbage disposal station available in Fruitland. Ask caretaker for more information.
3. Cleaning: Campers are responsible for cleaning up after themselves in the camping areas, the restrooms, and other facilities they have used before being cleared to leave camp.
4. Alcoholic Beverages: Not permitted on Camp Na-Bor-Lee grounds.
5. Fire Rings: Only established rings are to be used. Rings are not to be relocated. Fires must be out and cool to touch before leaving camp. *Fires subject to local fire restrictions.*
6. Digging: Is prohibited; this includes trenching around tents and digging holes for RV wheels.
7. Boat Launching: Is prohibited, except for those boats or canoes that can be carried down by hand. No vehicles are to go beyond the high-water line. No overnight mooring or tie-ups of boats for non-campers within ½ mile.
8. Parking: Vehicles of all guests (both overnight and day use) must park in designated parking areas. Driving inside the gates is to be from the gate nearest the camp site ONLY. Driving must be kept to a minimum to preserve the turf and keep dust down.
9. Animals: Horses are prohibited. Dogs must always be kept on a six-foot leash and kept away from the swim area and other campers. Animal waste must be cleaned up by owners. Violators will be asked to leave. A possible \$50 fine for violators. Please be considerate of others.
10. Firearms are prohibited on NPS grounds.
11. Fireworks are prohibited.
12. Noise: 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM is quiet time. This includes all motors and generators. Please be considerate of other campers and noise levels during non-quiet time as well.
13. Motorcycle/ATV Riding: Is prohibited inside the gates. Bicycles should be ridden carefully with consideration for other campers and turf.
14. Fire lanes are to be kept clear at all times.
15. Gates: Are to be closed except when someone is passing through. Gates will be locked when campsites are not in use.
 - a. Fire rings 1 and 2 (east), 3 and 4 (center) use the EAST gate.
 - b. Fire rings 5, 6, 7 (west), 8 and 9 (far west) use WEST gate.
 - c. Kitchen/Caretaker gate is for kitchen supply deliveries and maintenance ONLY. Not to be used by campers.
16. Kitchen: Cooks MUST have current Food Handlers Card posted while using the kitchen. Each group is responsible for the safety of their own food service and is to leave the kitchen facilities and appliances clean.
17. Electrical Cord Use: Electrical cords can ONLY be plugged into the East Shelter or the Cabin. Due to fuses being blown a maximum of 4 cords can be plugged in at a time. Must be approved by Camp Hosts before use.
18. No Lifeguard on Duty. Unless provided by individual camps. Swim at your own risk!
19. Beach: No camping in the beach area (north of the fire lane). The beach is to be accessible to everyone using the camp. **All other National Park Service regulations apply.**
